1. The need to get new communication papers from our members is continuous.

2. This is a great possibility and the advantages for our members to publish at ECAP communication section and almost everything which could be of interest for the ESCAP aims and goals is welcome.

4. Usually this kind of paper is between 2000 words with an exception of maximum of 4000. There is no limit for the number of authors.

5. According to our original agreement with Springer, we could publish one communication paper per issue plus a presidential column every three issues, (12 papers and 4 pres. col. per year).

6. There is no cost for anyone, the publication is for free. Also access is open and for free.

7. The paper must be in its final form when sent for publication, this includes also the language. The paper should be ready for publication and approved by the Editor before sending it to ECAP secretary. It should include publication information as title, author names, author affiliations including country, and the full address of the corresponding author including e-mail address, who will receive the proof from Springer Nature.

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
