EU Horizon – FAMILY project

- 'Running in the FAMILY Understanding and predicting the intergenerational transmission of mental illness'
- Starts Oct 1st 2022
- The overall aim of FAMILY is to systematically integrate the family context in the study of mental disorders. FAMILY aims to identify mechanisms underlying the transmission of disease risk from affected parent to offspring, establish how resilience factors moderate risk factors, take a biomarker and resilience assessment approach to improve risk prediction, and map societal and ethical consequences of risk prediction.
- ESCAP will partner to help communicate and disseminate information out about the project as it progresses
