

## THE The Rome VENWention Center «La Nuvola»


designed by Italian architect **Massimiliano Fuksas**, is a striking modern venue known for its futuristic glass-and-steel structure resembling a floating cloud.

#### **Three Levels:**

- Level Meeting Halls: 9,000 sqm of modular space with 30 meeting rooms of all sizes, a plenary room that gathers 5.000 seats
- Level Forum: 7,300 sqm dedicated to exhibitions, gala dinners or product display
- Level Auditorium: 1.800 seats (1.200/stalls and 600/gallery); 3 external foyers (one of 1,500 sqm and two of 500 sqm each)

#### LOC will establish "meet & great" points at Rome Fiumicino Airport and Rome Termini Station.

- At these two hubs, conference staff will provide information and assistance regarding transportation.
- The LOC will share a *transport plan* that attendees can follow, removing the need to arrange their own transfers to and from the airport or station.
- Regarding accommodation, the organizing secretariat will handle room bookings at partner hotels, ensuring availability and guaranteed rates per night.
