•1921: Founding of the first child and adolescent psychiatric clinic.

Today, the SGKJPP connects hundreds of members, oversees training across five universities, and ensures the field's international visibility and a strong, multidisciplinary professional community.




WHY SWITZERLAND, WHY LAUSANNE?


- Walkable distances in Lausanne

The meeting of Georges Gilles de la Tourette with Lausanne (1901-1904)....










What are our values in the Lausanne child and adolescent psychiatry today?


- Prevention and community oriented
