There are also public transportations and taxi.

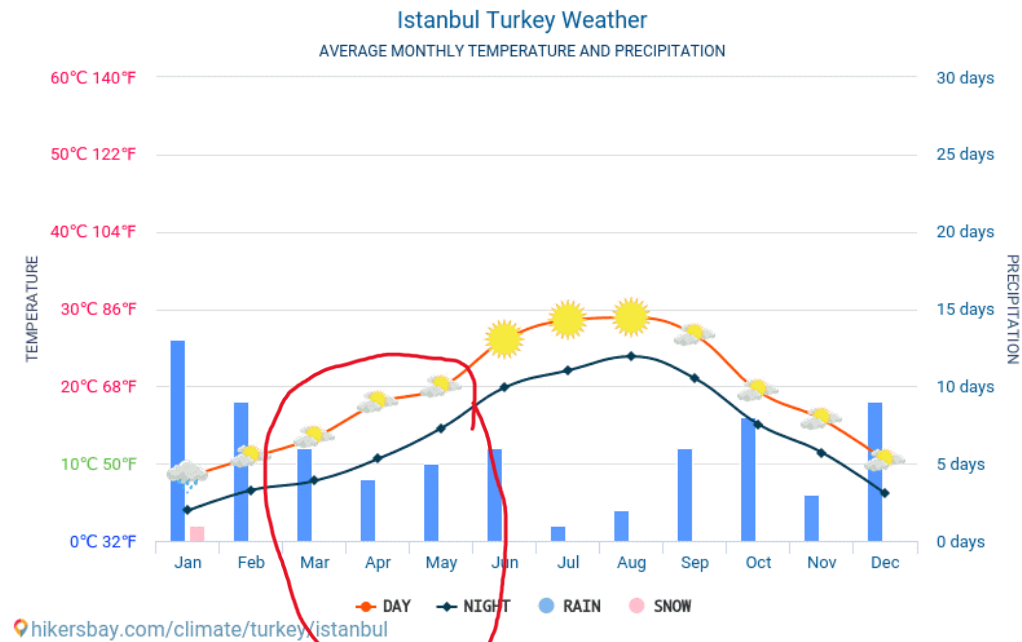




Istanbul

- Istanbul is a **“timeless city”**. “If the Earth were a single state, Istanbul would be its capital.” Napoleon Bonaparte said.
- Istanbul (historically Byzantium and later Constantinople) is, - the largest city of Turkey
- It was founded in 667 BC. In its long history, Istanbul served as the capital city of the Roman Empire, the East Roman (Byzantine) Empire, the Latin Empire, and the Ottoman Empire. **The city was chosen as joint European Capital of Culture for 2010. The historic areas of Istanbul were added to the UNESCO World Heritage List in 1985.**





Climate: The city has a temperate climate with extremely hot and humid summers; and cold, wet, snowy winters.

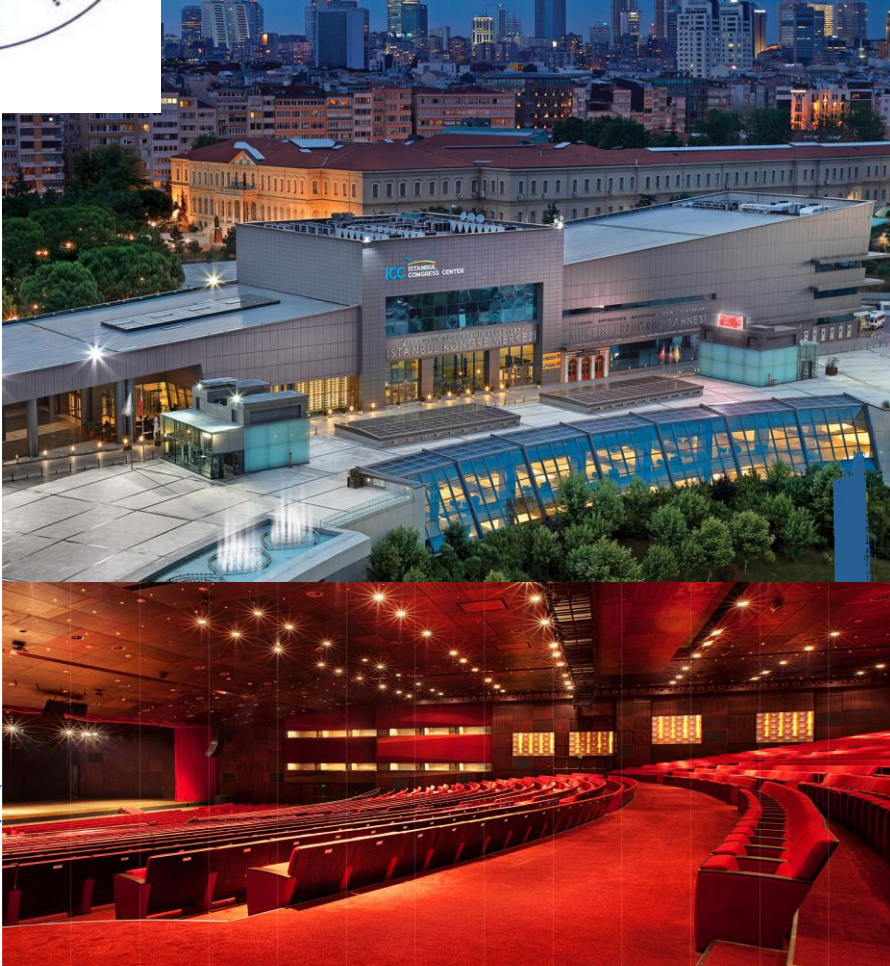
