The paper must be in its final form when sent for publication, this includes also the language.

The paper should be ready for publication and approved by the Editor before sending it to ECAP secretary.

It should include publication information as title, author names, author affiliations including country, and the full address of the corresponding author including e-mail address, who will receive the proof from Springer
