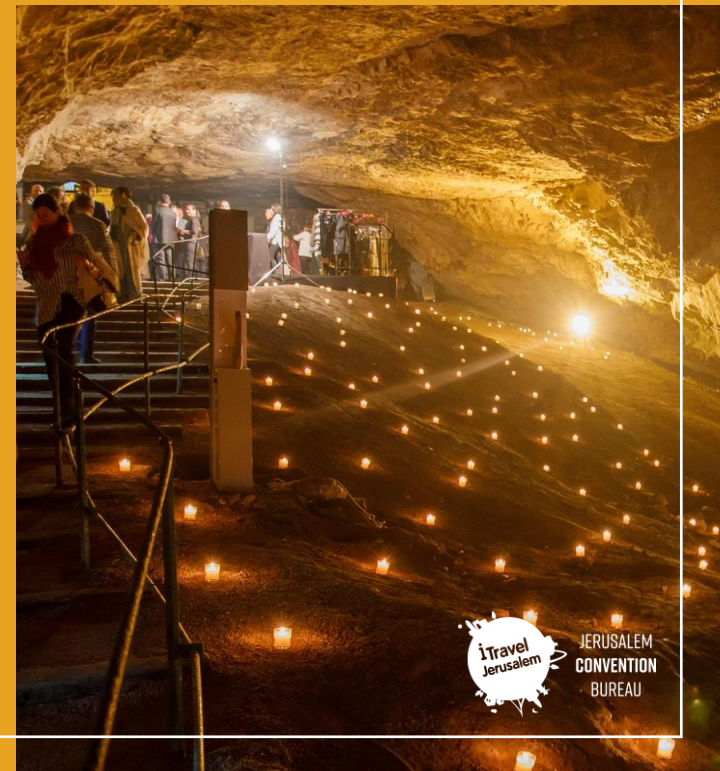

LEADING INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION CENTER

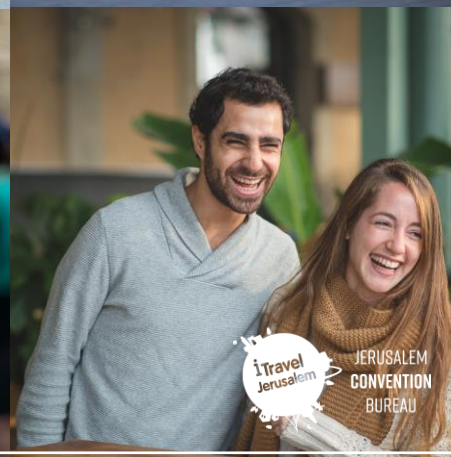


Inetrnational Conveincion Ceter (ICC) JERUSALEM
